## Cans for Cash Contest Info

Thank you to all who have begun to collect the **CANS FOR CASH!**

**These are your options for participating:**

Cans are to be taken directly to Wise Recycling located at 1554 Old Frankfort Pike, Baker Iron and Metal located at 740 Rockcastle Avenue, or Gordon Scrap Iron and Metal located at 637 Patterson Street anytime during the month of October- the person dropping these off needs only to tell Wise Recycling, Gordon Scrap Iron and Metal or Baker Iron and Metal personnel to "credit" **Maxwell Elementary** for contest purposes. Cans may be dropped off by friends, relatives of students, boosters, etc. Please note that Wise Recycling, Gordon Scrap Iron and Metal and Baker Iron and Metal will also "pay" for the aluminum cans dropped off at their facilities so even if **Maxwell** does not recycle enough cans to win one of the nine monetary prizes in the contest, we can still get paid for the cans we recycle.

Please note that Wise will send money to **Maxwell** at the end of the month. Gordon and Baker will pay "on the spot". You will just need to mention to give "**MAXWELL ELEMENTARY**" credit for your delivery!!!!!!!

Just like last year there will also be one optional drop-off day (this year it will be held on **Wednesday October 29**) in which cans may be brought to school. LFUCG Division of Waste Management personnel will then pick these cans up that day and transport these directly to Harry Gordon Scrap and Iron, Wise Recycling or Baker Iron and Metal where they will be recycled and credited to us.

Please note that there is no requirement to crush the cans but the cans must be empty- they cannot contain liquids. Also only aluminum cans will be accepted- not steel cans.
